The euROBIN SRA offers a roadmap for the future of robotics and AI in Europe.

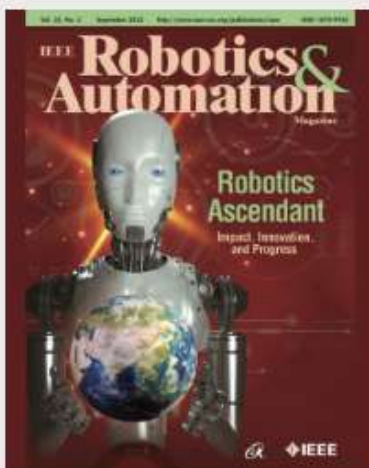

## Introducing ELLIOT Europe's Flagship for Open Multimodal AI

The new EU-funded project, ELLIOT aims to develop open, multimodal foundation models that can generalize robustly across real-world, noisy, and dynamic data streams.

With €25 million in funding under the Horizon Europe programme, ELLIOT brings together 30 research and industry organisations across 12 countries and will run from July 2025 to June 2029. Built for real-world impact and aligned with European values, ELLIOT aims to make Europe a global leader in robust, ethical AI.
